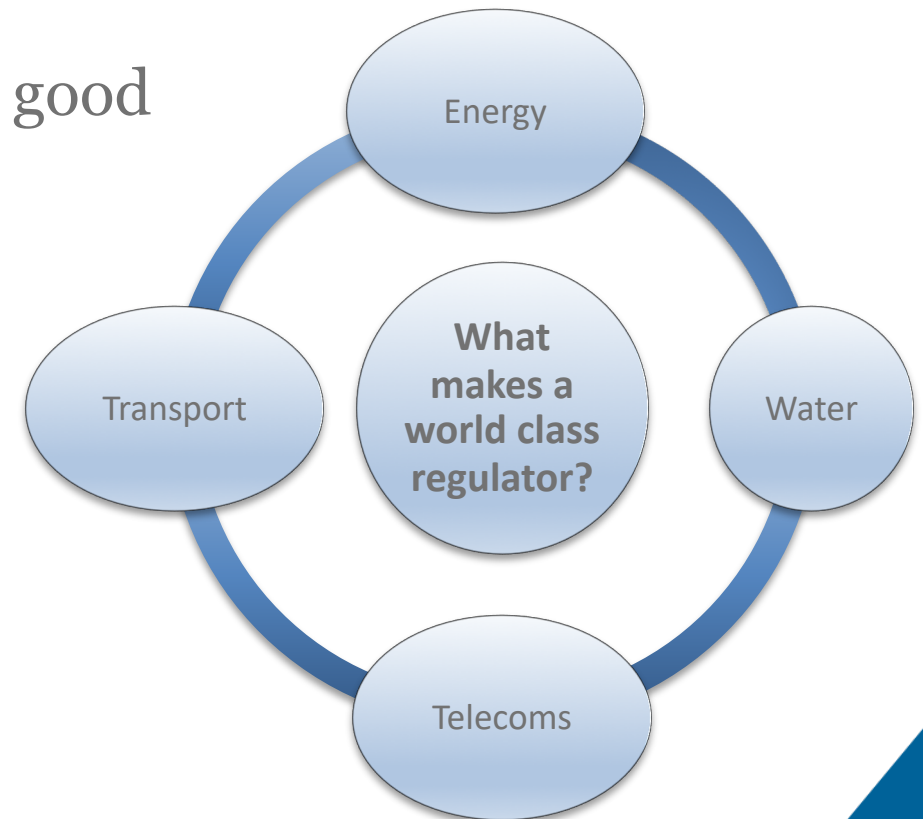


1. OECD sources, data and guidance



OECD Network of Economic Regulators (NER)

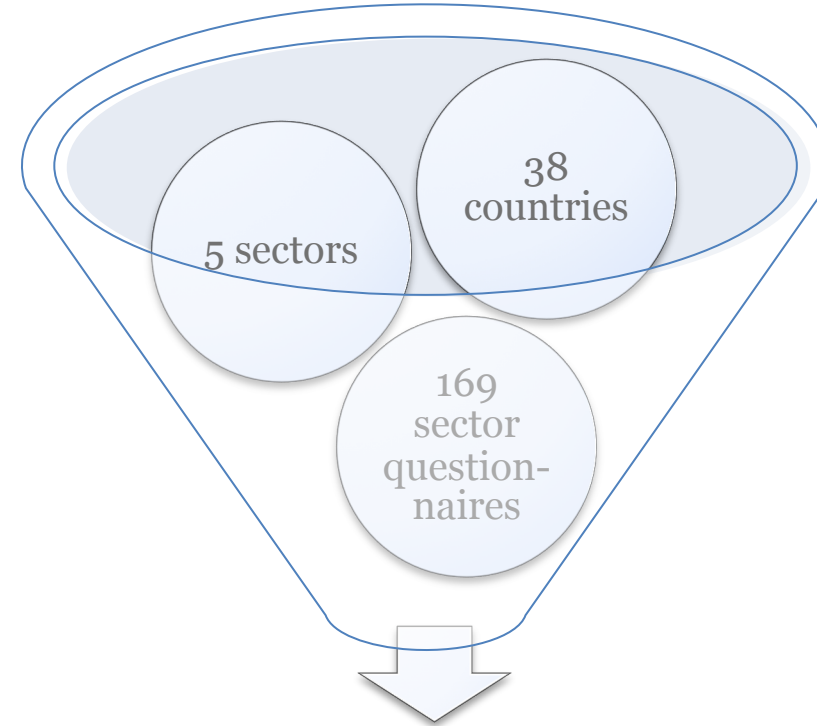
- Brings together over 70 regulators across sectors, countries and regions of the world.
- Open forum that promotes dialogue, shares good practices, generates analysis and guidance.
- Work on cross-cutting areas:
 - Performance
 - Governance
 - Independence
 - Behavioural insights
 - Market transformation
 - Emerging technologies

13,000 answers reviewed by the Secretariat

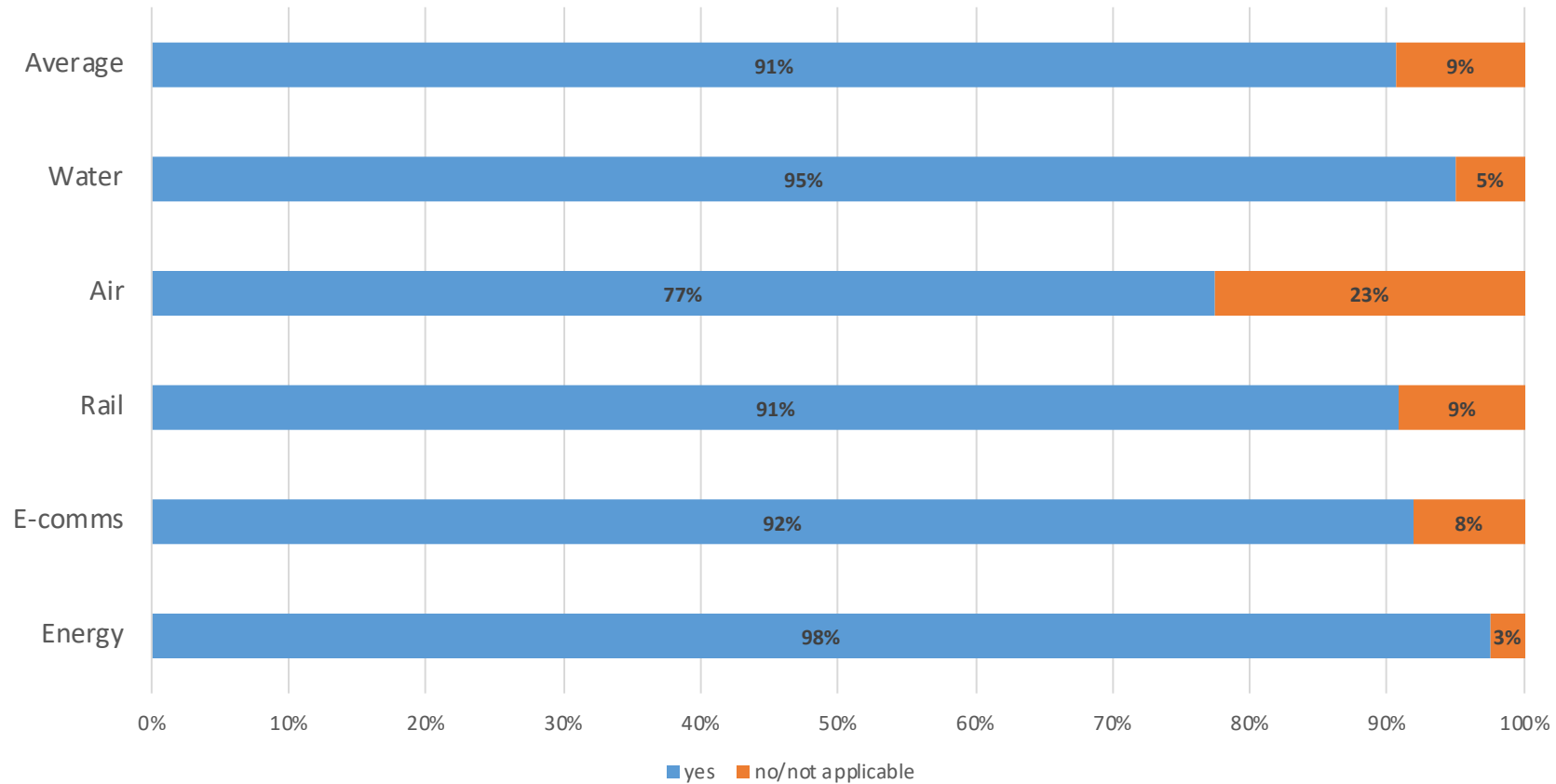


2. What data do regulators collect ?



Most regulators across sectors collect data on industry and market performance

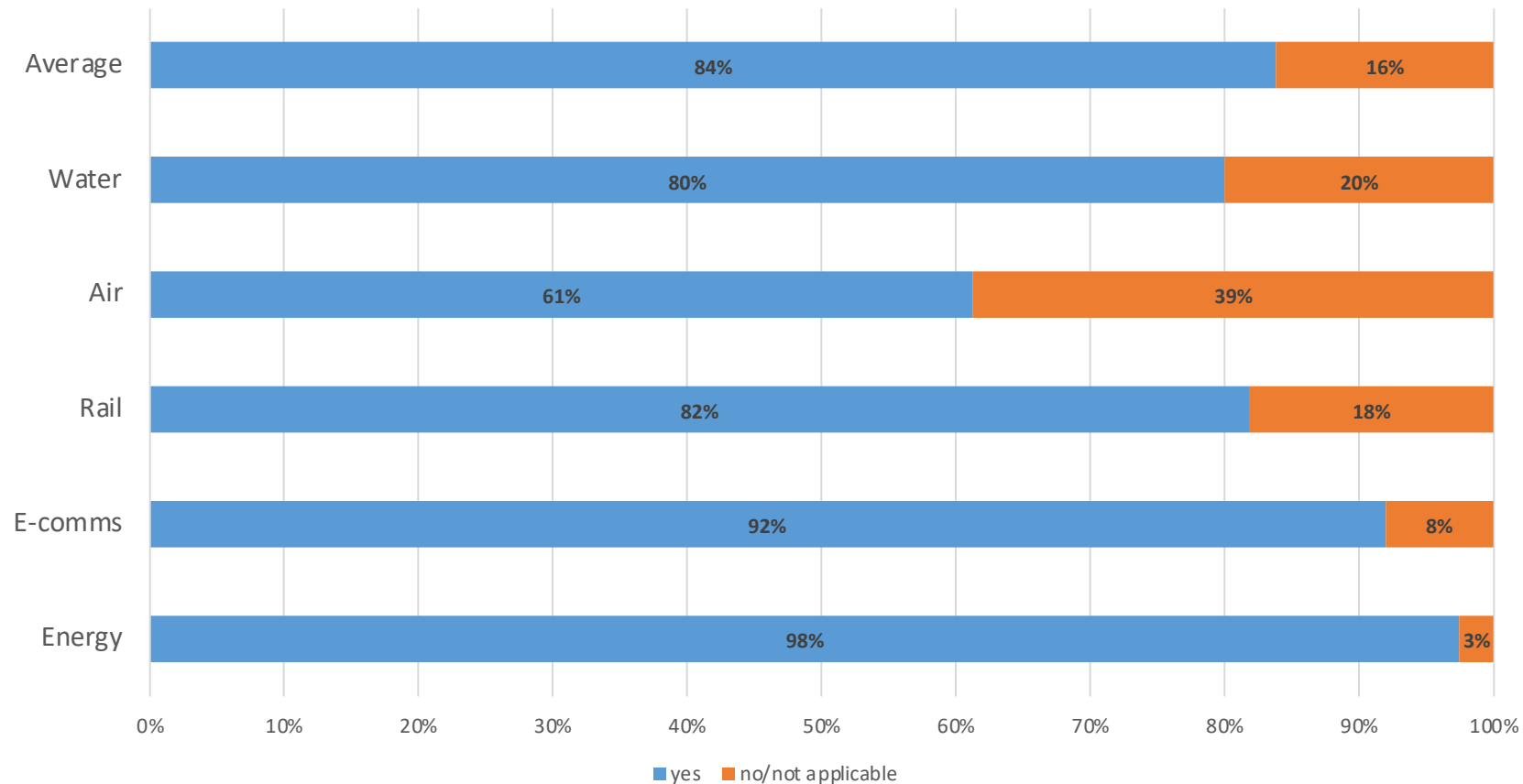
Does the regulator collect data on industry and market performance?





Most regulators (but less) collect data on the economic performance of the sector

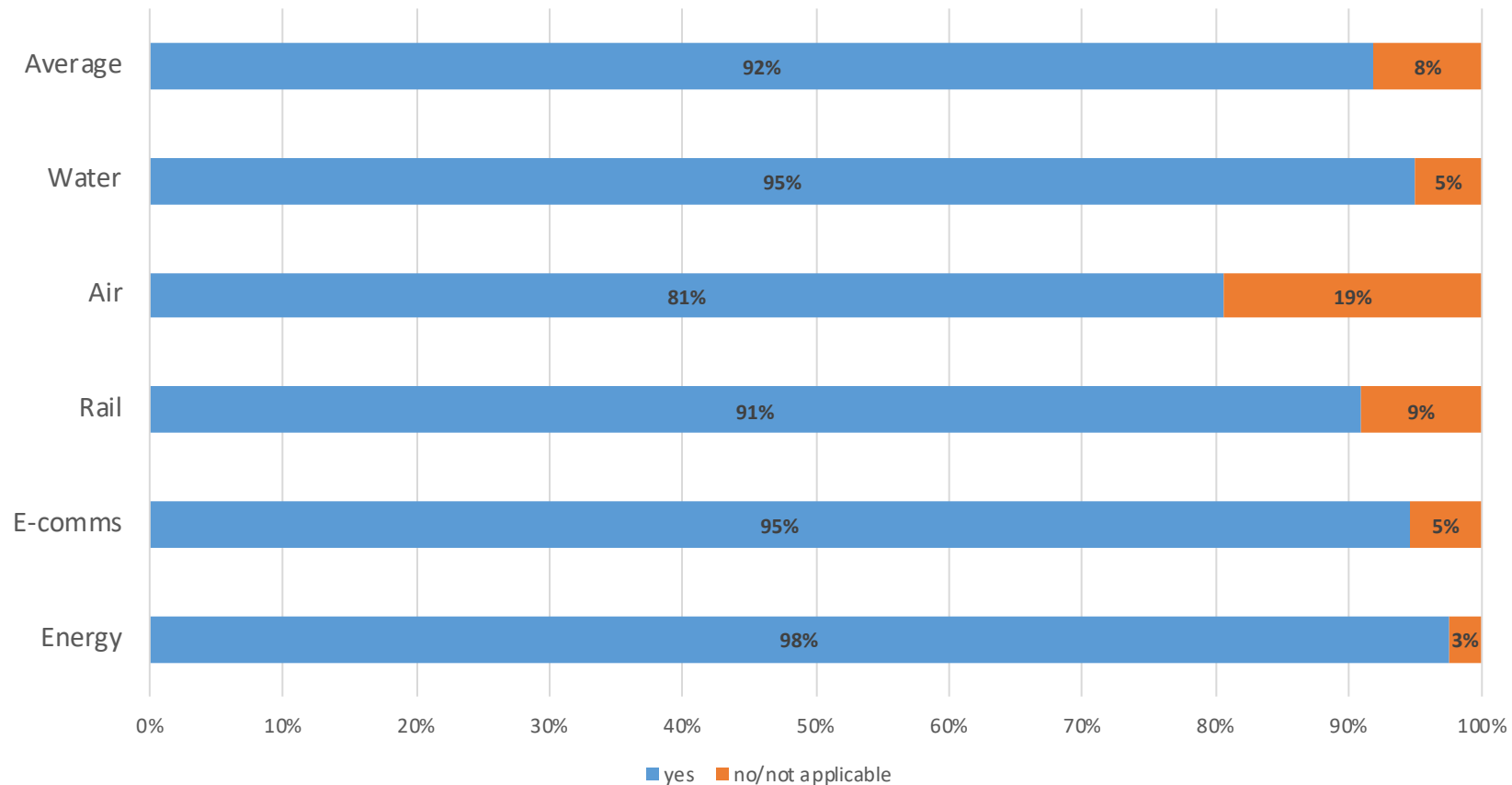
Does the regulator collect data on the economic performance of the sector?





Most regulators collect data on their own financial performance...

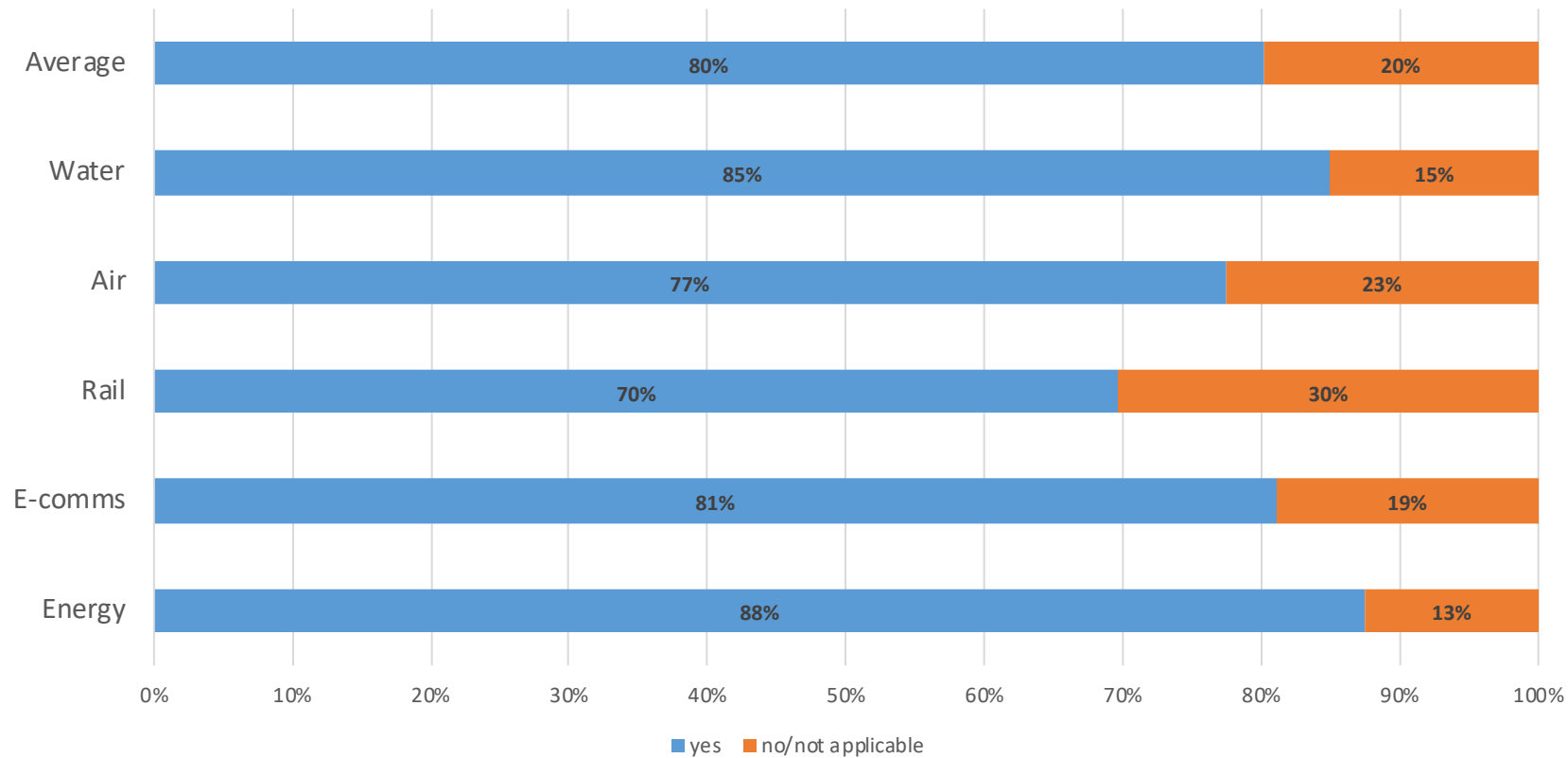
Does the regulator collect data on the financial performance of the regulator, including costs of operating of the regulator?





... but fewer on their own organisational/corporate performance

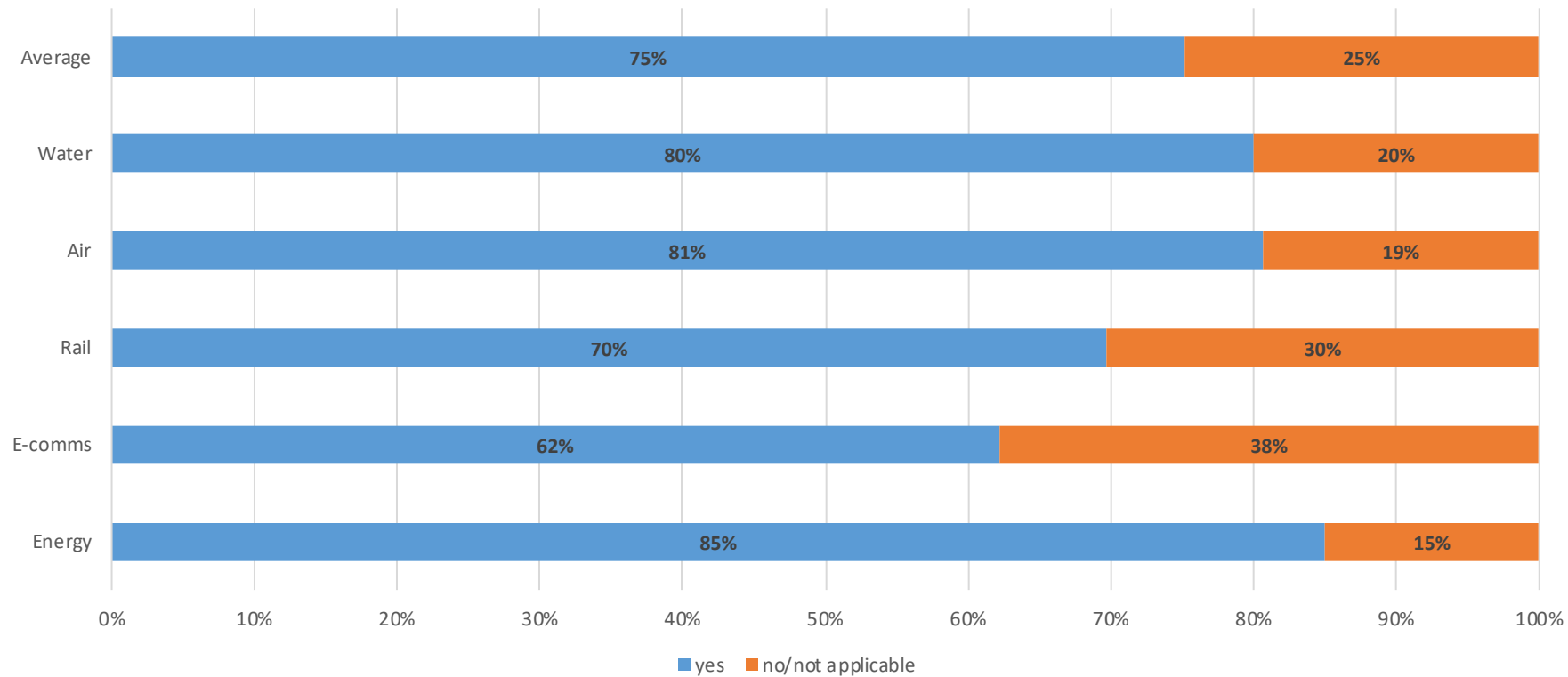
Does the regulator collect information on the organisational/corporate performance of the regulator?





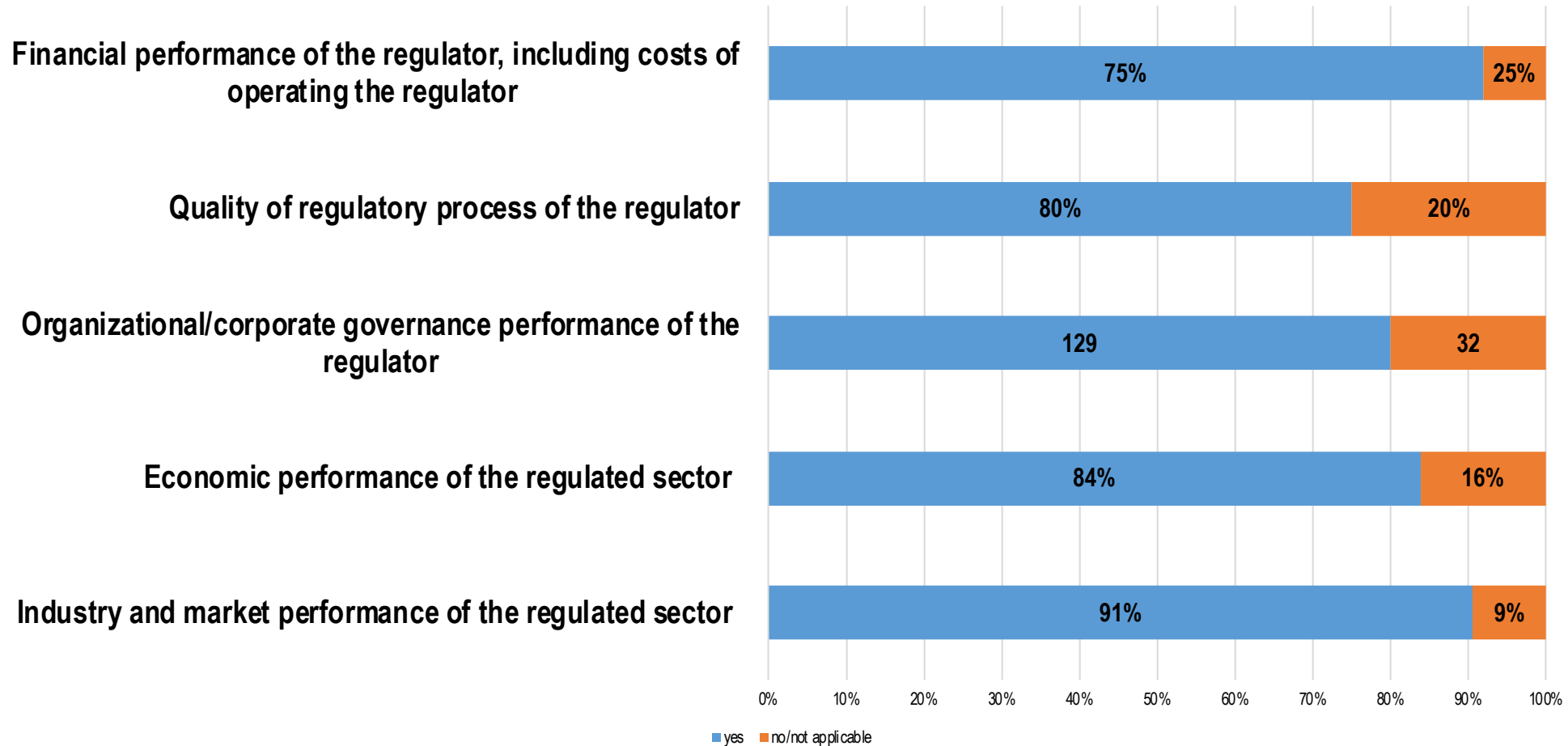
The same trend applies to data on the quality of regulatory processes

Does the regulator collect data on the quality of its regulatory processes?





Overview of data collection by regulators across energy, e-communications, air, rail and water



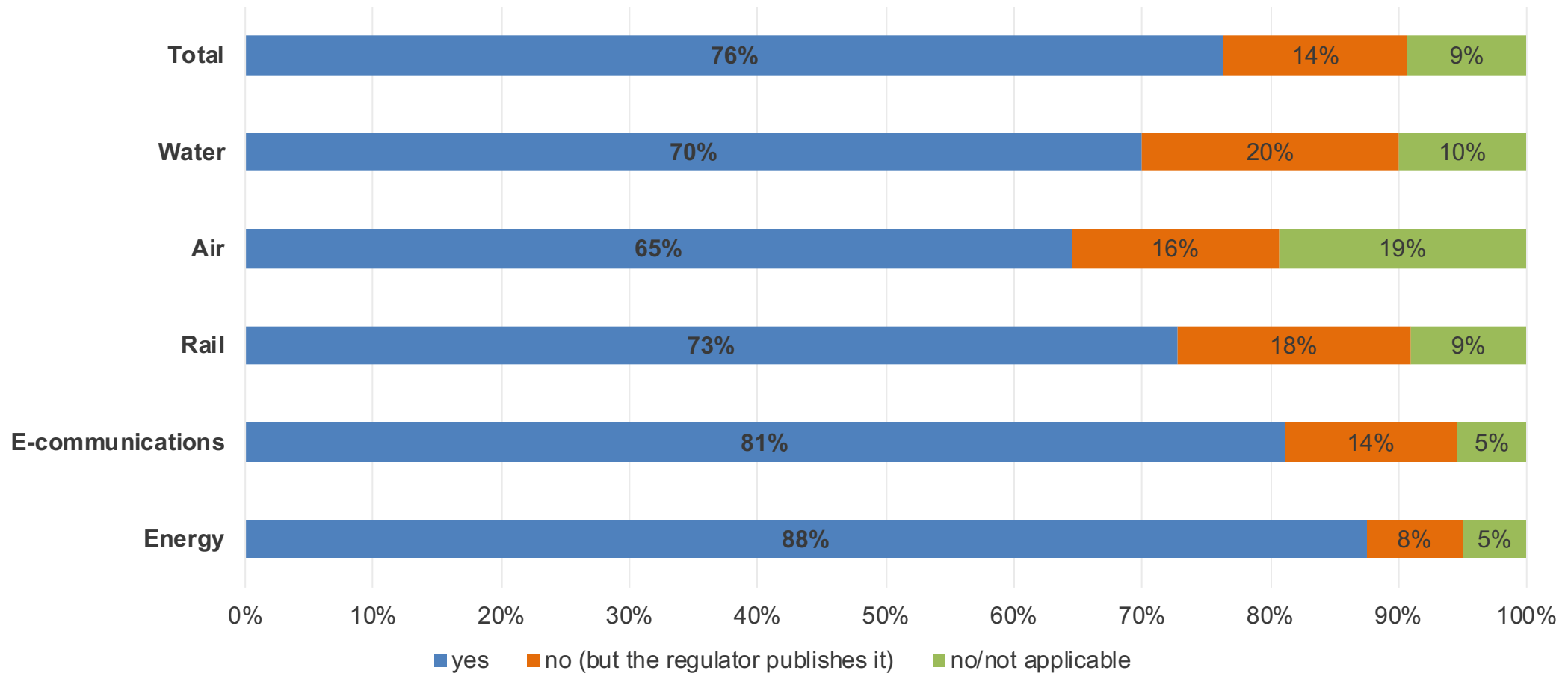


3. What do regulators do with this data ?



Most regulators publish a report on their activities, even when not required to do so by law

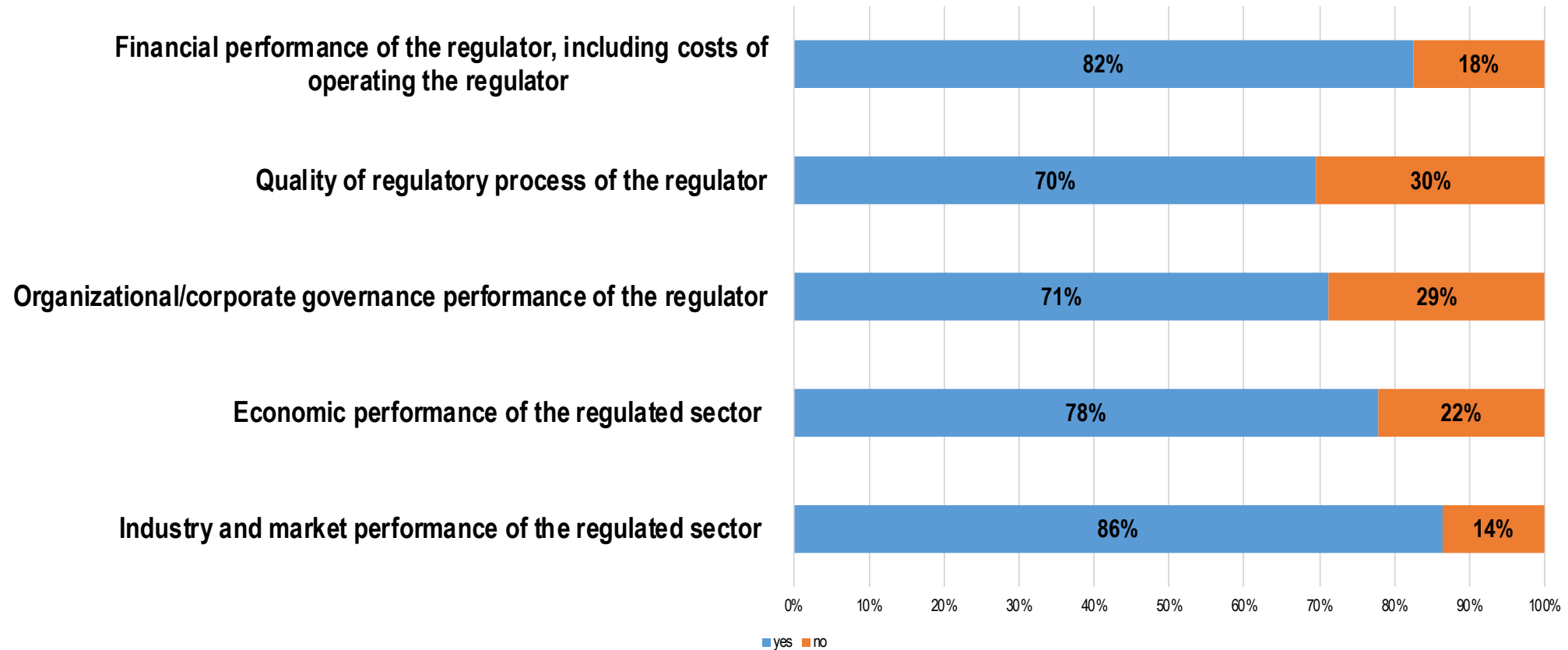
Is there a legal requirement to publish a report on the regulator's activities?





Most regulators publish performance information and data online

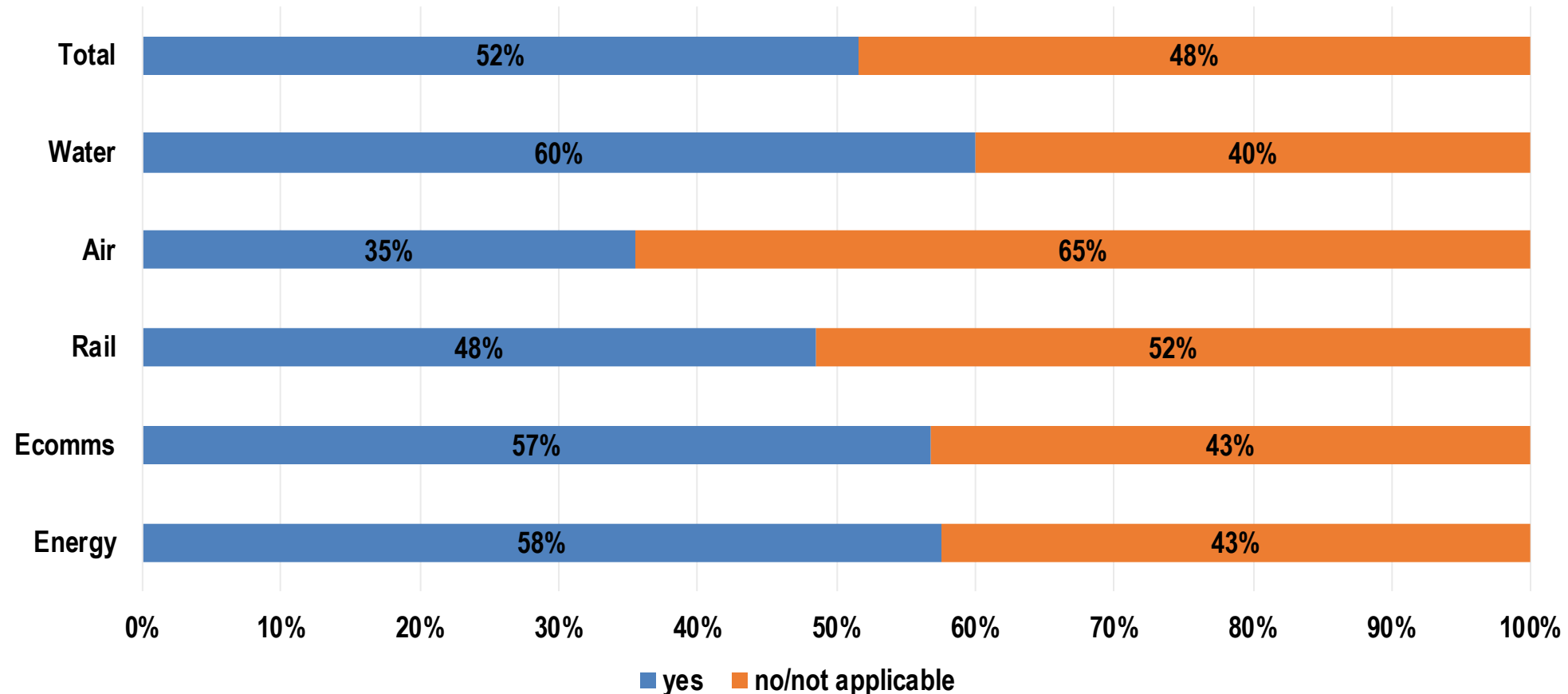
Among regulators who collect performance information, is the information published on the regulator's website?





Only half of surveyed regulators present a report on their activities to parliament

Does the regulator present a report on its activities to parliamentary/
congressional committees?
