He has been granted an ERC Advanced grant for developing an “Organizational Industrial Organization”. He is currently the managing editor of the Journal of Industrial Economics and a member of the European Advisory Group on Competition Policy at the European Commission.



Alessandro Riboni is associate professor at Ecole Polytechnique and research member of CREST. He received his undergraduate degree from the Bocconi University, and a PhD in Economics from the University of Rochester. His work lies at the intersection between macroeconomics and political economy.
