Lack of reliable information on the quality of mobile service. No suitable tool






A real desire on the part of users and local authorities to contribute to regulation

- Publication of theoretical coverage maps for operators
- Results of Arcep's quality of service surveys and measurements by third parties (including local authorities)



#### Mobile New deal dashboard

- Monitoring of obligations resulting from the Mobile New Deal including switch to 4G and "targeted coverage system"
- Cartographic and quantified data, detail by operator, at national and departmental level








# Construction of a theoritical schema

**OECD workstream** "Shaping the future of regulators" and study cases on data driven regulation approaches



# An outcome focused approach

#### **Objective 1**

#### • Enable users to make informed choices and better shepherd the market





#### **Objective 2**

• Amplify the regulator's ability to act, notably in a supervisory capacity



#### Mobile New Deal dashboard

- Follow up of reglementary obligations
- Transparency and reporting on new mobile antennas



#### **Internal Data Bases**

- On demand analysis
- retention of historical information



#### Automatic reporting

- Alert system if a specific theme appears repeatedly on J'alerte l'Arcep
- Reporting on data collection, etc.

### An outcome focused regulatory approach


An increase in network investment of **40%** in 4 years

An alliance with the crowd :

More than **100 000 alerts** collected on the platform in 3 years

+ direct impact on regulatory actions

An "Acces ID" API to characterize the user environment in the context of fix QOS measurement Implemented in the CPE of the ISPs
