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# Agile and responsible governance

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- ❑ Emerging and converging technologies : **high uncertainty**, **complex** and **speeding up**
- ❑ Decision makers (in government and other organisations) **are challenged to make choices *in spite of*** uncertainties and complexities

# Framing to get the ball rolling: RRI dimensions

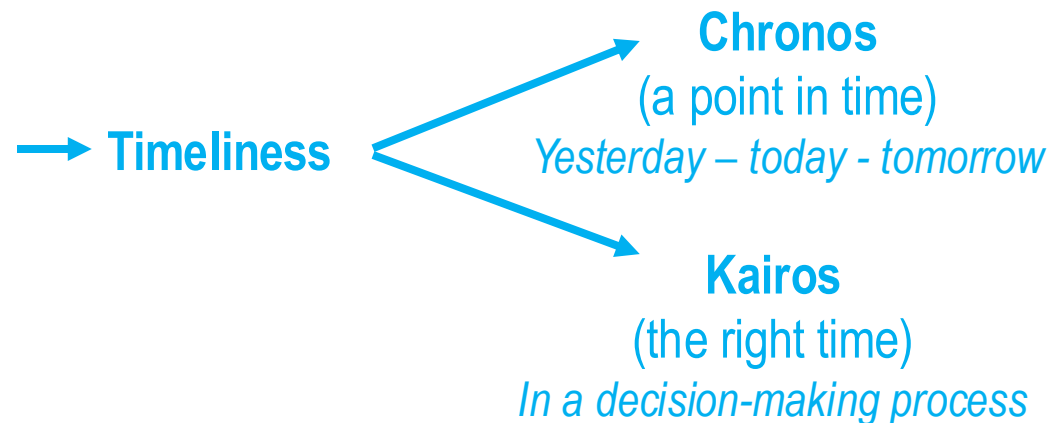
- Anticipation Prediction? Multiple possibilities?  
Near, mid, long-term?
- Reflexivity Be explicit about frames and biases  
(norms and values behind these)
- Inclusivity Who is included in intelligence production?  
Whose intelligence is used in decision making?
